

Several professional organists from the area who get to play pipe organs for a living.

- **You!** and a bunch of other students who, like you, are interested in this crazy, mysterious, and wonderful musical instrument.

- **Students** are encouraged to bring along a piano piece that we can help you play on the organ. All levels of proficiency are welcomed!

What We'll Do

- **We'll listen** to people describing how the organ works, and to people making music on the organ.
- **We'll look** at the insides of organs and find out what you don't see when you're on the outside listening.
- **We'll move** from First & Central Presbyterian Church (1101 N Market) to Grace United Methodist Church (900 Washington St.) to experience two different types of organs.
- **We'll play** Students will get a chance for some hands-on time with each organ.
- **We'll eat** some pizza at lunchtime and talk about what we've learned!
